Alumni Volunteer of the Year Award

Official Criteria: The Alumni Volunteer of Year Award is presented, when merited, to an individual or individuals who have provided outstanding service to the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association on a voluntary basis. A maximum of two candidates per year will be granted the Alumni Volunteer of the Year Award.

Nominations: All members of the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association and employees of the University may submit a letter of recommendation (one page maximum) for a candidate or candidates, illustrating their suitability for this Award. A completed Nomination Form (attached) must be submitted alongside the letter.

Selection: Candidates are considered annually by the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association's Awards & Nomination Committee, whose decision must be ratified by the Alumni Office. Under special circumstances, previous recipients of this Award may be considered for re-nomination.

Timeline: Consideration will take place following Spring Convocation, and this Award will be presented during Homecoming Weekend 2010 at the President's Wine & Cheese.

Note: The recipient(s) of the Volunteer of the Year Award will be eligible to assist with the selection of the criteria for the Alumni Association's annual Student Award (\$1,000).

Associate Alumni Membership

Official Criteria: Associate Alumni Membership is presented, when merited, to recognize an individual or individuals who did not attend Saint Mary's University, but have become important members of the campus community through their dedication, volunteerism, and/or support of the University and its endeavours. A maximum of three candidates per year will be granted Associate Alumni Membership.

Nominations: All members of the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association and employees of the University may submit a letter of recommendation (one page maximum) for a candidate, illustrating their suitability for this distinction. A completed Nomination Form (attached) must be submitted alongside the letter.

Selection: Candidates are considered annually by the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association's Awards & Nomination Committee, whose decision must be ratified by the Alumni Office. Recipients of Associate Alumni Membership are given full Alumni Association privileges. While previous recipients of this distinction are ineligible for re-nomination, re-nominations of previous candidates are welcome.

Timeline: Consideration will take place following Spring Convocation, and Membership(s) will be granted during Homecoming Weekend 2010 at the President's Wine & Cheese.

Distinguished Community Service Award

Official Criteria: The Distinguished Community Service Award is presented, when merited, to a member of the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association who has made an outstanding achievement and/or contribution in their community, discipline, or to Saint Mary's University.

Nominations: All members of the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association and employees of the University may submit a letter of recommendation (one page maximum) for a candidate, illustrating their suitability for this Award. A completed Nomination Form (attached) must be submitted alongside the letter.

Selection: Candidates are considered annually by the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association's Awards & Nomination Committee, whose decision must be ratified by the Alumni Office. While previous recipients of this Award are ineligible for re-nomination, re-nominations of previous candidates are welcome.

Timeline: Consideration will take place following Spring Convocation, and this Award will be presented during Homecoming Weekend 2010 at the President's Wine & Cheese.

Young Alumni Award

Official Criteria: The Young Alumni Award is presented, when merited, to Young Alumni for truly outstanding achievements that may have earned them regional, national or international recognition or prominence through: (a) service to humanity, (b) their professions and/or volunteer organizations, (c) community service, (d) the advancement of knowledge, or (e) service to Saint Mary's University. This Award is granted to Saint Mary's University Alumni within 10 years of receiving a Bachelor's degree or within five years of receiving a Graduate degree. A maximum of three candidates per year will be granted the Young Alumni Award.

Nominations: All members of the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association and employees of the University may submit a letter of recommendation (one page maximum) for a candidate, illustrating their suitability for this Award. A completed Nomination Form (attached) must be submitted alongside the letter.

Selection: Candidates are considered annually by the Saint Mary's University Alumni Association's Awards & Nomination Committee, whose decision must be ratified by the Alumni Office. While previous recipients of this Award are ineligible for re-nomination, re-nominations of previous candidates are welcome.

Timeline: Consideration will take place following Spring Convocation, and this Award will be presented during Homecoming Weekend 2010 at the President's Wine & Cheese.
